### **Open House**

Open house will be August 23<sup>rd</sup> from 5:30-7:30pm. Open House is an informal night with a two-hour window where families can meet their teachers, reconnect with returning staff, meet new staff, check out new classrooms, and bring supplies if they'd like for their lockers. We will also have an activity fair in the Rush campus cafeteria from 4:30-5:30pm. This fair will include informational tables from different extracurricular groups at CCS. Stop by to see what groups your students would like to join or learn how to sign up yourself as a volunteer!

## **Building on the Rock Campaign Update**

Construction has been steady ever since school released this past spring, here's a rundown of our summer projects and a look at what's ongoing!

#### Summer projects @ Calvary

- Playground enhancements including another 2-level playset, basketball court, and additional slides.
- Asphalt parking lots!
- Make sure you watch the traffic flow videos in the app (in the open house tile and the campus plan tile) because traffic flow will be different at CR9 due to construction. To reduce cars backing up on the long drive to CR9 we will have lanes which will merge. Our families will flow in one direction and busses will operate in the opposite lane (see parking videos for full explanation).
- Mr. Hyde's office has moved to CR9 and Mr. Carter has moved to the Rush office.
- The CR9 phase 1 addition (3 classrooms) has been completed. This will host K5 and elementary specials during the fall semester and will be junior high science, high school science, and high school history in the spring semester.
- Mrs. White has moved to the new addition in phase 1 for elementary music and art.
- We are on schedule with phase 2 to move into this building over Christmas break. Our plan is to move items from Rush campus over from January 6-10 and then organize the items from January 13-17. We'll have an open house on January 17<sup>th</sup> from 5:30-7:30 and our first day of school in the new building will be January 21<sup>st</sup>!
- We'll release a new parking lot flow video for spring semester around Thanksgiving time.

All of these projects combined will take an estimated \$8,500,000. We believe the work that is happening now will bless our families both immediately and for decades to come! There is certainly a lot of planning and a lot of faith as we step through this process. Please continue to pray for God's provision and wisdom. Our goal for this year is to cash flow the \$1.2 million of purchases that are needed to fill the building with needed items, we currently only need \$500,000 to meet that goal!

#### **ARRIVAL TIME**

- CR9 (K5-3<sup>rd</sup> grade) campus will open doors at 7:45am. Classrooms will open at 8:05am. Morning supervision will be available for students from 7:45am until classrooms open.
- Rush campus should arrive for the school day no earlier than 7:45am. No morning supervision will be available. 4<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students may go directly to their homerooms at 7:45am.
- K4 students can arrive for the school day at 7:45am. Morning supervision will be available for students in their classroom from 7:45am until school begins at 8:15am.

## Lunch, Chapel, and Special Transportation

Lunch will be served this year from Tuesday-Friday which means Monday will be the day to pack lunch at both campuses. Rush campus lunch will continue to be in the cafeteria and CR9 campus lunch will be in classrooms (one of the last annoyances remaining! The phase 2 building will have a beautiful cafeteria, almost there!)

K4-3<sup>rd</sup> grade chapel will be on Wednesdays, Mrs. Childers will transport those grade levels to Rush campus for lunch and chapel. 4<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade chapel will be on Fridays. Mr. Joey Adams (Mr. Adams has his BA in Biblical Studies and M Div from Cedarville University) will continue to serve as school chaplain and will direct chapel services at CCS. The chapel program includes a student worship team leading chapel all year, two spiritual reset weeks (at the start of each semester), and an evangelism conference in March.

CR9 students will have weekly specials on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday (art, gym, music, technology) at the CR9 campus. Mrs. White will teach art and music, Mrs. Carter will teach gym, and Mrs. Dillon will teach technology.
